DARRI and Institut Carnot "Pasteur Microbes & Health" Call 2020

FOR EMERGING INNOVATIVE PROJECTS: EMERGENCE2020-call

The "Direction des Applications de la Recherche et des Relations Industrielles" (DARRI) and the Institut Carnot, "Pasteur Microbes & Health", launch an internal call to support innovations that show the potential to have a positive impact on healthcare. The EMERGENCE2020 call aims to start the innovation chain by supporting early stage disruptive innovative idea that could lead to a new product.

All domains are concerned, from diagnostic/prognostic to therapies, including research tools, and from vaccines to precision medicine.

1- Expected results at the end of the proposed program

The call supports the early stages of development of new ideas that could lead to a dominant patent supporting the development of disruptive product for industry with significant social impact including clinical benefits, as well as for global health product. Demonstration of the innovation added-value compared to on-going / technologies or setting up of a novel product is the major objective of the program.

> Expected deliverables

- Data supporting basis of the disruptive innovation.
- Demonstrate in a first experimental approach that the proposed innovation could

address an unmet medical/ or technological need, or have high added value related to existing products.

- Novel intellectual property for the Institut Pasteur.

2- Eligibility

The call is open to all the Institut Pasteur Paris entities.

The call is selective to promote projects which novelty and originality are explained in regards to the state of the art, or, total absence of prior art.

3- Program funding

Equipment and salary of PhD students are not eligible for funding.

Please note that employees of Institut Pasteur can be recruited in the context of internal mobility.

Selected projects will receive up to 70 k€ / year for a duration of 12 to 24 months (= up to 70k€ to 140 k€ / project) including salary and running costs.

4- Programs selection procedure

The selection is a one-stage procedure:

- 1) The application form must be requested and sent back when completed to emergence2020@pasteur.fr.
- 2) Selection:
- programs will be analyzed by an *ad hoc* evaluation committee composed of representatives of Institut Pasteur including Advisory Committee on Innovation (ACI). External industrial experts (1 or 2 -under commitment of confidentiality-), chosen by DARRI, and will also be part of the evaluation committee.
- during the evaluation period, the evaluation committee reserves the right to ask for some additional information to the applicant. These requests will be sent anonymously.
- The evaluation committee also reserves the rights to ask to applicants to present their project to the evaluation committee.
- 3) The final decision of funding will be taken by head of DARRI.
